

Identifying a Location for the Halifax Food Hub

The Halifax Regional Food Hub (HRFH) is an active and emerging non profit co-operative committed to building and strengthening Nova Scotia's local food system by connecting producers throughout mainland Nova Scotia to wholesale buyers within the Halifax Regional Municipality.

The Hub will strengthen Nova Scotia's local food infrastructure by creating efficient channels for food distribution. The Hub will provide services including aggregation, storage (dry, cold and frozen), marketing, online ordering and payment processing, order fulfillment and last mile delivery.

The HRFH budget includes funding for leasehold improvements and capital expenses and is seeking to access a below-market lease. We are looking for 2000-2500 sq. ft or a space with expansion potential to support future growth of the HRFH.

With \$850,000 secured through the Nova Scotia Community Economic Development Fund, the HRFH is poised to take its next steps and secure a location.

Our ideal location is in the HRM, within thirty minutes of downtown Halifax and within close proximity to commercial kitchens and community organizations. The Halifax Regional Food Hub is a place for collaboration and welcomes any interest from aligned organizations looking to access rental space.

Space Considerations:

- Warehouse facility (minimum of 2000 square feet)
- Grade-level loading bay
- Waste management system
- Administrative office or workspace and staff room
- Sufficient access points to the building for ease of access for delivery vehicles
- Proximity to transit routes and parking for staff

We are open to co-locating with like minded businesses and organizations. Please reach out if your organization's vision and goals align with those of Halifax Regional Food Hub.
